High-altitude Bandol rosé, Mourvèdre based. Fresh, precise with a saline finish.

Production: 7,766 x 6pk cases (46,600 bottles).

VINEYARD DETAILS

High-altitude vineyard: plots between 369 and 416 m.

Soil: rudist limestone over Turonian blue marls.

Exposure: hillside vineyards and dry stone terraces (*restanques*), south and north west facing.

Vine age: 35 plots, from 4 to 50 years old.

VARIETAL COMPOSITION

MOURVÈDRE 71% | CINSULT 23% | GRENACHE NOIR 6%

HARVEST DETAILS

Harvest dates: September 12 (Cinsault) to September 21 (Mourvèdre).

Harvesting: hand-picked in small crates. Sorted in the vineyard and again at the winery.

Yield: 27.1 hL/Ha.

VINIFICATION AND AGING

Pressing: slow, low pressure under 0.55 bar, tailored program for each variety.

Settling: light, 200 to 250 NTU.

Alcoholic fermentation: spontaneous, with grapes' indigenous yeasts. No malolactic fermentation.

Aging: 5 months in stainless steel tanks on fine lees.

2025 VINTAGE WEATHER CONDITIONS

- Winter: relatively dry and mild.
- Spring: warm and very rainy, with 302 mm from March to May.
- Summer: very hot, 2.8°C above average, and arid, with only 26 mm from early June to late August.
- September: storms totaling 199 mm enabled optimal final ripening.

Impact on Domaine de La Béguide Rosé 2025: exuberance, complexity, finesse.

TECHNICAL ANALYSIS

Alcohol: 12.5% • Sugar: 0.2 g/L • T.A.: 4.5 g/L • pH: 3.49.

FOR SOMMELIERS

Serving temperature: 54°F (12°C).

Vegan pairing: roasted piquillo peppers with Herbes de Provence.

Classic pairing: sea bream ceviche with fennel and green apple.

Technical closure: DIAM 5 Origine. Provence sourced cork.
